Trent Hills Community Toolkit

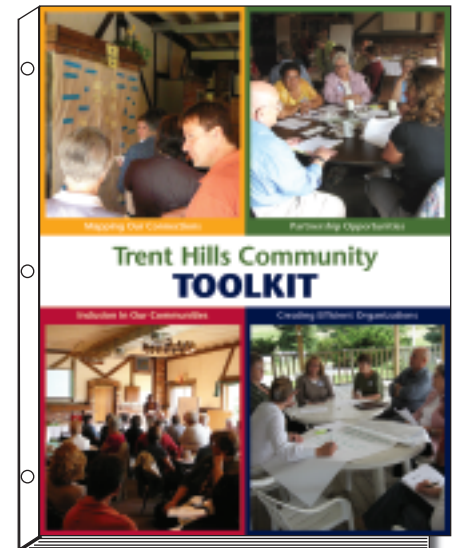
