Outright Gift: Gifts of cash, securities or properties can be donated to the Campbellford/Seymour Community Foundation.

Memorial, Testimonial, or Celebration Gift: Donations may be made in honour of an individual or an event.

Life Insurance Policy: You can donate a life insurance policy to the Foundation, and pay over a period of time, or in a lump sum. Your premiums are considered a charitable donation and will earn a tax credit.

Wills: No one wants to talk about Wills, but increasingly, forward thinking people are realizing that once they have provided for their family and loved ones, it is important and appropriate to provide for the charities they have supported during their lives. A bequest in your Will let's you do just that.

Establish a Corporate Giving Program: A business may find it advantageous to use the Campbellford/Seymour Community Foundation as a vehicle for its community giving.
