The Campbellford/Seymour Community Foundation was instrumental in surveying the community in 2004/2005, to find out which large-scale projects would be supported by our community.

On February 7, 2006, a Steering Committee was established to investigate all large-scale project possibilities and communicated their results to the community on June 26, 2006.

The Steering Committee's recommendation for an initial Large-Scale project focus was as follows:

- Multi-Use Facility (could include a variety of activities).
- Also to maintain support for other projects and encourage proponents to continue their work.

The Steering Committee turned the next phase of the project development over to an already established Multi-Use Recreational Facility (MURF) Committee.
